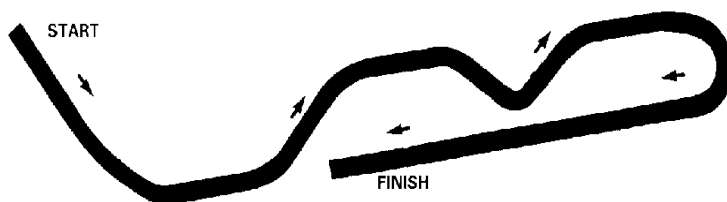


SHENSTONE AND DISTRICT CAR CLUB LTD. MEMBERS ONLY SPRINT MEETING AT CURBOROUGH SUNDAY 18th MARCH 2012



SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

[1] The Shenstone and District Car Club Ltd. will organise a Clubmans Permit Sprint Meeting on Sunday 18th March 2012 at Curborough Sprint Course near Lichfield, Staffs.

[2] Held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and the Supplementary Regulations.

[3] MSA PERMIT NUMBER : **67787**

[4] The event is open to members of the Shenstone and District Car Club Ltd only.

[5] All competitors and drivers must produce a valid Competition Licence and Club Membership Card. (A properly completed and signed licence application form, together with the appropriate fee, may be accepted in lieu of a Competition Licence.)

[6] The event is not a round of any championships.

[7] The programme of the meeting will be:

8.00 am Signing on and scrutineering starts.

9.00 am Timed Runs commence.

Any competitor not signed on by 12.00 Midday may be excluded.

[8] The length of the Course is 900 yards (823 metres) and consists of a tarmac surface not less than 15 feet (4.57 metres) wide with several fast curves.

[9] There are no classes, but all vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations.

[10] There will be no awards.

[11] The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes on Friday 9th March 2012.

The ENTRY FEE is **£49.00**. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by a currently dated cheque/P.O. (cheques will not be banked before 9/3/12). In accordance with MSA rules, entries can be accepted by E Mail but must be through the www.curborough.co.uk web site on the prescribed form with the acceptance of the event regulations indicated by completion of the tick-box facility. No E Mail entry will be finally accepted until payment has been received by the Entries Secretary.

[13] The maximum entry for the meeting is 70. The minimum is 40.

Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting. Entries will be selected in order of receipt. Post-dated cheques and incomplete entry forms will not be accepted. Entry fees will be refunded if the competitor notifies the Secretary of the Meeting of cancellations in writing before the closing date. Cancellations received after the closing date will incur an admin fee of £10 which will be deducted from any refund given. Any competitor who fails to sign-on and has not notified the Secretary of the Meeting of a cancellation will receive a refund of the M.S.A. fees only. Acceptance of entries after the closing date (where possible) will incur a late entry admin charge of £5 per entry. There will be no refunds in the event of the meeting being cancelled or curtailed after practice has commenced. Change of nominated driver by an entrant will be accepted, BUT change of driver and vehicle will be classed as a cancellation. A car may be driven by any number of drivers provided an entry form has been completed and fee paid for each driver. There is no restriction on the number of cars a driver may drive provided an entry form has been completed and the appropriate fee has been paid.

SHARED CARS: The onus is on the Competitors to ensure that BOTH entry forms are received before the closing date for entries or before the entry list is full.

[15] Provisional times will be published during the meeting at the Paddock Office.

[16] Starting order will be determined by the organisers. Cars will start singly. The starting signal will be a green light. The method of timing will be from a light ray at the start to a light ray at the finish. The finish line will be indicated by chequered boards and a white line. A timing strut in accordance with S. 10.9 of the 2012 MSA Competitors Yearbook is required.

[17] Competitors will have the opportunity of a minimum of three timed runs, having walked the course under official control.

[18] Competitors will be identified by numbers, which WILL NOT be provided by the organisers.

[19] Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the MSA General Regulations. A penalty of 0.50 seconds will be added to competitor's times if on any run they touch the marker on the apex of the first left hand bend (i.e. opposite the flagpole).

[20] All other regulations of the MSA apply as written.

[21] Protests must be made in accordance with section C 5.1 & 5.2 of the 2011 MSA Competitors Yearbook.

[22] All drivers must wear an approved crash helmet with the correct MSA approval label, and overalls at least to the minimum standard required. (Ref: K 10 helmets & K 9 overalls)

[23] NOISE: A noise check to MSA regulations J.5.17 & J. Appendix 1 (Chart 5.18) will be carried out and those cars over the limit may be excluded.
