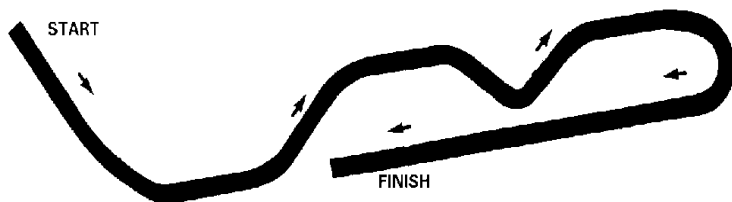


SHENSTONE AND DISTRICT CAR CLUB LTD. MEMBERS ONLY SPRINT MEETING AT CURBOROUGH SUNDAY 24th MARCH 2019 (single lap)



SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

[1] The Shenstone and District Car Club Ltd. will organise a Clubmans' Permit Sprint Meeting on Sunday 24th MARCH 2019 at Curborough Sprint Course near Lichfield, Staffs.

[2] Held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (MSA) (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.

[3] Motorsport UK PERMIT NUMBER: **110288**

[4] The event is open to members of the Shenstone and District Car Club Limited only.

[5] All competitors and drivers must produce a valid Competition Licence and Club Membership Card. (A properly completed and signed licence application form, together with the appropriate fee, may be accepted in lieu of a Competition Licence.)

[6] The event is not a round of any championships.

[7] The programme of the meeting will be:

8.00 am Signing on and scrutineering starts.

9.00 am Timed runs commence.

Any competitor not signed on by 12.00 (midday) may be excluded.

[8] The length of the Course is 900 yards (823 metres) and consists of a tarmac surface not less than 15 feet (4.57 metres) wide with several fast curves and a hairpin corner.

[9] There are no classes however; all vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations.

[10] In accordance with guidance issued by the Motorsport UK titled 'Hybrid & Electric Vehicles V1.0 Dated 29/09/2017' specifying requirements for accepting entries from these vehicles, SDCC cannot accept any entries from hybrid or electric cars.

[11] There will be no awards. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes on Friday 15th March 2019

The ENTRY FEE is £62.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by a currently dated cheque/P.O. (cheques will not be banked before 15/3/19). Bank account details for a bank transfer of an Entry Fee can be provided on request to the Entries Secretary on entries@curborough.co.uk. In accordance with Motorsport UK rules, entries can be accepted by E Mail but must be through the www.curborough.com web site on the prescribed form with the acceptance of the event regulations indicated by completion of the tick-box facility. No E-Mail entry will be finally accepted until payment has been received by the Entries Secretary.

[13] The maximum entry for the meeting is 70. The minimum is 40.

Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting.

Entries will be selected in order of receipt. Post-dated cheques and incomplete entry forms will not be accepted. Entry fees will be refunded if the competitor notifies the Secretary of the Meeting of cancellations in writing before the closing date. Cancellations received after the closing date will incur an admin fee of £10 which will be deducted from any refund given. Any competitor who fails to sign-on and has not notified the Secretary of the Meeting of a cancellation will receive a refund of the Motorsport UK fees only. Acceptance of entries after the closing date (where possible) will incur a late entry admin charge of £10 per entry. There will be no refunds in the event of the meeting being cancelled or curtailed after practice has commenced. Change of nominated driver by an entrant will be accepted, BUT change of driver and vehicle will be classed as a cancellation. A car may be driven by any number of drivers provided an entry form has been completed and fee paid for each driver. There is no restriction on the number of cars a driver may drive provided an entry form has been completed and the appropriate fee has been paid.

SHARED CARS: The onus is on the Competitors to ensure that BOTH entry forms are received before the closing date for entries or before the entry list is full.

[15] Provisional times will be published during the meeting at the Paddock Office.

[16] Starting order will be determined by the organisers. Cars will start singly. The starting signal will be a green light. The method of timing will be from a light beam at the start to a light ray at the finish. The finish line will be indicated by chequered boards and a white line. A timing strut in accordance with S.10.9 of the 2019 Motorsport UK (MSA) Competitors Yearbook is required. (S9.4.6.) Drivers will be under Starter's Orders when instructed by an Official to proceed to the Start Line. If a Competitor takes undue time to comply, the Clerk of the Course, or his Deputy, may specify that he comes forward within two minutes or he will forfeit his run.

[17] Competitors will have the opportunity of a minimum of 2 practice runs (S 2.1.1) and three timed runs, having walked the course under official control.

[18] Competitors will be identified by numbers, which WILL NOT be provided by the organisers.

[19] Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations. A penalty of 0.50 seconds will be added to competitor's times if on any run they touch the marker on the apex of the first left hand bend (i.e. opposite the flagpole).

[20] All other regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written.

[21] Protests must be made in accordance with section C 5.1 & 5.2 of the 2019 Motorsport UK Competitors Yearbook.

[22] (S 9.2.1) Throughout practice and competition, upon exiting from and until returning to the Paddock, when the driver is seated in the vehicle he must wear clothing, helmet and goggles complying with K.9 to 11. Overalls homologated to either FIA 8856-2000 or FIA 1986 standard are mandatory with the exception of Standard Cars (11.9) where overalls must comply with K9.1.4. Only FIA homologated rainwear is permitted. Competitors are required to wear flame-resistant gloves (K.14.3(e)). An FIA approved FHR device, fitted in accordance with FIA regulations is mandatory for all drivers with the exception of Period Defined Vehicles, Road-going Series Production Cars and Road-going Specialist Production Cars. All these items must be produced for inspection and approval at scrutineering.

[23] NOISE: A noise check to Motorsport UK regulations Silencing J.5.17. & J.5.18. Appendix 1 (Chart 5.18) will be carried out and those cars over the limit may be excluded. CAMERAS: On-board cameras are subject to J5.21.

CATERING WILL BE AVAILABLE THROUGHOUT THE DAY. PLEASE NOTE THAT IN ORDER TO PROVIDE YOU WITH A CHEAP DAYS MOTORSPORT NO AWARDS ARE BEING GIVEN, THEREFORE NO CLASSES APPLY. BUT CARS MUST COMPLY WITH Motorsport UK REGULATIONS FOR THIS TYPE OF EVENT.
