Competitors On arrival - Proceed to paddock area and park in the Paddock as per allocated parking places on the Paddock Bay sheet. Go to the Paddock Office to sign on. You will NOT Practice if you have not signed on.

All Scrutineering will be in your allocated paddock positions please make sure you are in attendance at the vehicle. noise testing will be done in the assembly area on your first practice run.

Officials & Marshals - will sign on in the paddock office from 08.15am.

Competitors wishing to walk the course must do so before 8.45am.

At Signing on you will need:

MSUK Competition Licence this MUST be signed on the back.

For Scrutineering you will need:

Your Car to comply with MSUK Regulations applicable to this event

A log book for your vehicle if applicable with J.2.1

An approved crash helmet with the correct MSUK approved label and clean overalls to the required minimum standard.

Refuelling - Please take care when Refuelling in the paddock area.

Marking and penalties - ALL FOUR WHEELS ACROSS THE WHITE LINE AT THE EDGE

OF THE TRACK WILL RESULT IN A NO TIME RECORDED. Judges of fact will be the course

controller, chief startline and the IC at post two, three, officials names will be posted on the

notice board. The notice board is located at the Paddock Hut. All results are deemed to be provisional until the conclusion of any judicial actions.

AS PER SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS THE CONE TO THE LEFT OF THE FLAGPOLE ON THE FIRST LAP WILL IF KNOCKED DOWN INCUR A 1 SECOND PENALTY.

TYRE WARMING IS NOT PERMITTED - TYRE WARMING AND PRACTICE STARTS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE RETURN ROAD, this is a public footpath and such actions will be deemed in breach of MSUK regulations.

Camping Overnight - The circuit will be open from mid afternoon on Friday for people wishing to camp overnight. Please ensure that you camp in YOUR allocated paddock position or at the top of the circuit.

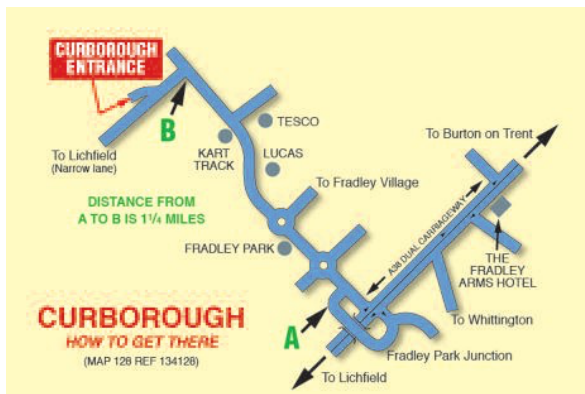
